



- Key Requirements:
 - For New Construction and Major Renovations
 - Created Separately From the Long Range Facility Plan (To Be Incorporated Into the LRFP)
 - Must Be a Written Document and It Must Be Adopted by the Board of Trustees

• An Educational Specification Shall Be Created for Each Campus Type.



- The Long-Range Facility Plan Is a Written Document, That Will Be Approved by the Board of Trustees and Provided by the District to the Architect. It Will Include:
 - Existing and Proposed Instructional Programs Offered at Each Campus, Including, Special Education, Dual Language, Course Offerings, and Partnerships;
 - The Age and Condition of all Buildings and Systems at the Project Campus;

NEW LONG-RANGE FACILITY PLAN

- Elements:
 - * A Site Evaluation of Each Campus, Including:
 - * Overall Size; Shape; Useable Land;
 - * Suitability for Intended Use As Well as Planned Improvements;
 - * Adequate Vehicular, Pedestrian, and Emergency Access; Queuing; Parking; and
 - * Site Amenities.
 - * The District's Educational Specifications;
 - * The District's Enrollment Projections; and
 - * The Security Compliance Status of the Safety Standards Required in Subsection

NEW LONG-RANGE FACILITY PLAN - COMMUNITY

- Go With a Framework Do Not Give the Impression That You Are Starting From Scratch
 - * Community Input Is Important and Required, but You Need To Be Prepared To Explain Your Educational Specifications
 - * Input Is To Augment the LRFP
- There Is no Specific Direction on How To Get the Input
 - * Community LRFP Meetings and "Citizen's Bond Committee" Are Not Synonymous.
 - * LRFP Establishes Standards That Will Assist Future Bond Committee With Decision Making and Prioritization

- Proof of Compliance.
 - * The Requirement for a Long-Range Facility Plan Is Met When:
 - * A School District Completes the Applicable Long-Range Facility Plan.
 - * Presents It to the Board of Trustees
 - * Provides It to the Prime Design Professional for the Project

The long-range facility plan shall be updated after five years.


