

Title IX Discrimination Dismissal Form

Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 (20 U.S.C. § 1681) is a federal law that prohibits discrimination based on sex in educational institutions that receive federal financial assistance. A Formal Complaint of sexual harassment must be dismissed if alleged conduct, even if proved, would not constitute sexual harassment, did not occur in a school district program or activity, or did not occur in the United States. A Formal Complaint may be dismissed if a Complainant notifies the Title IX Coordinator that he/she would like to withdraw the complaint or any of the allegations therein, the Respondent is no longer enrolled in the district, or specific circumstances prevent the district from gathering evidence sufficient to reach a determination.
